

Survey work on Nundle Road at Nemingha from 16 January 2025

January 2025

EnergyCo is carrying out survey work at Nemingha to inform our planning for the New England Renewable Energy Zone (REZ).

What are we doing?

We will carry out survey work of the bridge over Cockburn River in Nemingha, along Nundle Road. The bridge inspection will predominantly be carried out using drones equipped with cameras to take high resolution images.

The drone will be flown overhead, alongside and underneath the bridge and will be controlled by an operator via a remote control. This is part of our work to understand local road conditions.

Work location:

- Along Nundle Road at Nemingha and the bridge over Cockburn River.

Work hours and timing

We will be working from **Thursday 16 to Friday 17 January 2025** between 9am and 5pm. We expect to complete the work in two days, subject to weather conditions.

What will this mean for you?

The road will remain open and there will be minimal impact to road users while we are carrying out the visual inspection.

The inspection will be carried out in accordance with all Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) regulations and approved procedures for drone flying. The drone will be flown a safe distance of over 30 metres from any vehicles and members of the public.
