

# Survey work on local roads from Monday 24 March 2025

March 2025

EnergyCo is carrying out survey work on local roads to inform our planning for the New England Renewable Energy Zone (REZ).

#### What are we doing?

We will carry out survey work in the road reserve using handheld survey tools, mounted tripods and light vehicles.

This work is necessary to inform our environmental assessment and design for the New England REZ.

Work will be carried out at various locations along the preferred study corridor, from south of Muswellbrook to north of Armidale.

#### Work hours and timing

We will be working from Monday 24 March between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday.

Work will be carried out over a 3-month period, starting at the southern end of the corridor. Work is expected to take about one hour at each location.

## What will this mean for you?

The road will remain open and there will be minimal impact to road users while we are carrying out survey work. Work areas will be signed 'surveyors on road' while the surveys are carried out.

If any access to private property is required, we will consult with landowners directly to arrange access.

Activities on local and state roads may require traffic control, reduced speed limits and temporary lane and shoulder closures for the safety of pedestrians, workers and motorists. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment. Noise from these activities is expected to be minimal. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
